All dogs present must be on leads or confined to crates when not being judged, except when in the exercise area or designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs!

If anyone observes that you did not clean up after your dog, you will be asked to leave the trial site for the remainder of the weekend without refund! **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

RIBBONS & PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded for **First** through **Fourth** place to qualifying dogs in all height divisions. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. **Ring size is a minimum of 100' X 100'.**

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Walk-throughs are restricted to handlers entered in that class. Two warm-up jumps will be provided.

Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height classification. Handlers may opt to run in a higher division, but not a lower one than their proper height division in regular classes.

Please Note: Dogs competing in AKC Agility who do NOT have a permanent or temporary jump height card **MUST** be measured by a VMO, an AKC rep, or the trial Judge. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running.

Entry confirmation will no longer be sent out by regular mail.

They will be sent via email only, unless otherwise requested by the exhibitor. One email confirmation will be sent when the entry is originally received, and a second email confirmation will be sent after the trial closes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES

Telegraph, telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on **Official AKC Entry Forms** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. **Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted.** Entry Forms **MUST** be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry. Owners are responsible for errors made on their completed entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or cancellation of entries, after published closing date. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Maximum of 10 dogs per envelope for mailed entries. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY.**

ENTRY FORMS: Please double check that your entry form is **COMPLETELY** filled in, marked, and signed. Please do **NOT** staple or tape any attachments to your entry forms. **ILP and PAL registration numbers must have the letters ILP or PAL preceding the number! Please print entry forms landscape.**

Dogs Health and Safety: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC limited registration, or have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved FSS breeds. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season and aggressive dogs are ineligible to participate. Dogs that are blind or deaf, or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its ability to perform agility obstacles, are ineligible to participate. Dogs under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC agility trials.

Refunds: Entry fee minus \$5.00 per class entered per day will be refunded for bitches who come in season after the close of the trial. The Trial Secretary must receive written certification from a veterinarian no later than 9:00AM day of trial for a refund to be issued. Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **A \$20.00 service fee will be assessed all returned checks.**

MOVE-UPS: Before the trial, dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner or handler, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, **providing that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on the Monday before the Trial.** Requests after that time will not be accommodated. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. Dogs who earn a title at the trial may move up the following days, providing that the request is made to the Trial Secretary by the close of the trial on the day the title is earned.

RUNNING ORDER SEPARATION: Running Order Separation of multiple dogs handled by a single handler is an accommodation by the OCOD and is **NOT** required by AKC! **Requests for separation MUST be made prior to the start of the Class (Excellent, Open, Novice or Preferred), otherwise they will not be accommodated.** (Applies to both STD, JWW, & games classes)

READY TO RUN!: Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. OCOD and stewards have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. All dogs being judged should be available 30 minutes prior to the start of a class.

RESPONSIBILITIES: It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
