



- C. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman.
- D. A proof will be sent before ordering to be sure spellings and awards are correct, and must be returned to Chairman with approval.
- E. All plaques and tags must be paid for in advance of order.

AGILITY NEWS

The Club's Annual Agility Trial and FAST CAT Event is right around the corner. The 3 day event is held at Silver Sands Bridle Club on 415 in New Smyrna Beach. As always, we are in need of Volunteers to help make this fun filled Trial a success. And the best part is that No Experience Is Necessary.

Agility Trial Volunteers Needed

Trial Set Up: Thursday, January 20th @ 9 am. This is the day that we need the most help from Club Members. Rings need to be set up, crating areas defined, equipment needs to be assembled and various other tasks need to be performed. Come for a couple of hours, come for the day.....there is a task for everyone.

Trial: January 21, 22 and 23 starting @ 7:15 am till late afternoon.

There are many positions we need covered in order to provide our competitors a great experience. In order for our program to grow we need competitors to return and recommend us to their friends. The positions are fun and easy to learn.

The Inside Ring Crew has one of the easiest jobs and is closest to the action! Watching the amazing dogs and handlers running the course makes the day go by guickly.

Inside Ring Crew Consists Of:

- 3 Bar Setters who are responsible for putting dropped bars back in place, changing the height for jumps, A-Frame and the pause table.
- 1 Leash Runner who is responsible for moving the leash from the ring entrance to the exit.

The Outside Ring Crew is not a difficult job, but does require a bit of skill to do the jobs. You will still be able to enjoy the action in the ring, but at times your focus will be on the job at hand.

Outside Ring Crew Consists Of:


Gate Steward who is responsible for checking in the dogs before the ring starts, dealing with ring conflicts and calling out the running order once the judge is ready to begin. The Gate Steward is NOT responsible for hunting down the next dog in line. It is the Handlers responsibility to arrive at the gate in time for their scheduled run. **Sheet Runner** who is responsible for taking the score sheets to the Trial Secretary.

Scribe who is responsible for marking down the Judge's calls during each of the runs.

Timer who is responsible for signaling the running team to Go/Ready, making sure that the timer starts once the dog passes over the timer eyes, and to manually track the time for those choosing to do a Fix N Go in the ring.

Course Builders are needed to work with our Chief Course Builder. This job is physically demanding but teamwork lightens the load.

General Meeting Minutes

October 11, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 7:08pm by Vice President Kris Davenport.

Sign in sheet was passed around – 16 members were present and there were no guests.

Wins and Brags were announced. Any new ones should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks.

Minutes of the last meeting were not read but were published in the Chatterbarks.

Report of the Secretary: There were three new applications for membership: Diane Ashley (S) Palm Coast, Jen Huppert (S) Ponte Vedra Beach, Debbie Kiely (S) NSB.

Report of the Treasurer: Renee said we made a good profit at the scent trial and we should have more of them. She also wants to thank Lynn Weaver for donating her Judges fee to the Building Fund. Our next Scent Trial will be April 22nd, 23rd, and 24th, 2022. The Golden Retriever Club wants their August Trial dates for next year which will be August 12th, 13th, and 14th 2022. Terrie Brensinger's Raffle Basket has brought in \$582 so far. They are still selling tickets the drawing is tonight. Terrie also brought homemade decorated Halloween cupcakes.

Pat Mozden's building update was about working on an ongoing leak problem in the downstairs utility room. It is still a work in progress. Regarding the nominating committee Pat said that Linda Hudak is stepping down as President this year and so are two other board members. Michele Lemole has been nominated for President, Pat Mozden for Vice President, Renee Johnson for Treasurer, Chris Franczek for co-treasurer, Linda Campagna for Secretary, Kris Davenport, Anna Johnson and Linda Hudak for Board Members. Chris Franczek will be taking over the portion of the processing of online payments. Kris said we will be voting on the Board Members at the December Meeting and if anyone is champing at the bit to be a Board member we would still accept nominations from the floor.

The deadline for Vicki Owens ordering plaques and tags for the Awards at the Banquet in December is November 1st. The plaques will cost \$29 and the tags are \$8.50. You can send the check in by mail to the club P.O. Box or put your order and check into an envelope and drop it into Vicki Owens file in the file cabinet in the desk. Keep in mind that the mail is running slow these days.

Claire is reminding us about the Awards Banquet, Christmas Party and gift exchange. The food will be catered by Olive Garden and served as a buffet. There will be a selection of various pasta dishes. For those who would prefer an entrée of ham and potato could be substituted. There will also be sweet tea, salad, and breadsticks. The club is providing desert. This will be on Monday December 6th. Kris said they run their little hearts out chasing a plastic bag. If you do it at Silver Sands the fee is \$30 and is best to register ahead of time and pay when you get there. If you go to try Fastcat at a facility in NSB on Saturday nights the cost would be \$15. It's a fun sport. This is a good place to try it out to see if your dog likes it. If you need more information contact Terrie.

Nina said Kathy came to her house and gave her 4 dogs free massages. Her dogs just loved the messages. Kathy is doing 50 free massages to get her license. After she gets her license she will give a price break to OCOD members. Your e-mail will have more information on Kathy.

Claire wanted us to know that most people that responded to her survey liked the idea of a different style and different material for the new club shirts with a cool fabric and dry-blend. 


