If someone is dealing with behavioral issues with their dog please reach out. We can help you find appropriate help for you and your furry friend.

Excerpt from the standing rules:

TITLE AWARDS

B. All titles received by same dog may be purchased and will be printed on hanging tags with title and date earned.

C. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman.

D. A proof will be sent before ordering to be sure spellings and awards are correct, and must be returned to Chairman with approval.

E. All plaques and tags must be paid for **[by November 1st deadline]** in advance of order.

OCTOBER 9, 2023

Minutes of the last meeting were not read because they were published in the Chatterbarks newsletter.

Wins and Brags were announced and Kris congratulated everyone. Any new Wins and Brags should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks.

Report of the Secretary: There was one new application for membership. Bill Harvey (S) Port Orange. There was no correspondence.

Report of the Treasurer: Renee said we made \$8,700 from the Scent trial.

Joan received an invitation from a former student for us to come to the 'Flagler Beach Creates' day at Wickline Park on October 21, 2023. They are having a costume event for dogs and have asked if we could donate a gift card for a free OCOD class. Dana is going to do a demo and might get a couple of friends to go with her. Joan said if anyone wants to go and maybe set up a table to hand out flyers and talk about the club to please contact her and she will pass the information along.

Terrie spoke about our club dinner at Palmetto club on Monday December 4th which is the same place we went last year. They are offering your choice of Prime Rib, Chicken, or Fish and a baked or sweet potato. The dinner also comes with string beans, salad, coffee, tea or water, and Christmas cake. The cost for members is \$20 which includes the tip. We must have a minimum of 35 people signing up by Friday November 24. You can leave an envelope with your name, check and food preferences in Joan's folder before then. There will also be a voluntary gift exchange of a \$10 dog item. Joan will start checking in members at 5:30pm, and dinner will be served at 6:30pm.

Chris will be in charge of awards this year. The deadline to get your information to Chris is Nov. 1st.

Ralph said sign up boards are being circulated to schedule stewards for the Dec. obedience trial on the 8th, 9th, and 10th. People that want to sign up for steward will find out that the jobs are easy and the Judges will explain the job to you when you arrive. Ralph says we will have a really good professional photographer at the trial. If you want a Christmas background he can set it up. The photos he made for us were beautiful. We'll have lunch from Jimmy Johns. Anna will be having a Match on Saturday Dec. 2nd. Ralph rode in the Boggy Creek Camp ride that collects money for charity again this year. It's in Cassia, Florida and it benefits kids with disabilities and life threatening illnesses. Ralph raised \$2,130 and came in at 2nd place. The Tracking Class is coming up on Saturday Nov. 18th at Rock Springs. There is room for 12 entries. Class credits: Linda Hudak said if you check the members only section and then go to training documents you will find a list of everything Ralph needs for his class credits.

We have a night parade every year in Ormond. It is a one mile walk and periodically we stop for a few moments and turn toward the audience and do tricks and all kinds of stuff. It makes families very happy watching the dogs perform. Members wear their club shirts so we all match. We are required to have lights on the dogs which we get at dollar tree and decorate their outfits and leashes. It is very hard to get members to commit to walk in the parade because we have our trial on the same weekend. If you know anybody that might be interested please have them give me a call at 386 848-4594. Linda C. Kris asked if there was anything else... Joan motioned to adjourn, Pat Mozden seconded the motion.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:30pm.

OCOD'S DECEMBER TRIAL UPDATE BY RALPH ORLANDO, TRIAL CHAIRMAN

Hi All,

Gaining on us are our Rally/Obedience trials beginning with double Rally trials on December 8. Then for the weekend will we will have our Saturday and Sunday double trials. The plan is to overlap the two Rally trials as we did in July with one starting at 8 Am in ring #3 and the second trial starting at 10:30 in ring #1. The early judge will be Ted McCall. In the later trial in ring #1 the judge is Dr. Norine Noonan (Norine ran the Rally Nationals this year. The idea behind this plan is to shorten the work day for each judge and also to shorten the day for the exhibitors by most likely a couple of hours.

Then on the weekend there will be all of the regular classes as well as some non-regular and random rewards classes. The last ring running on Sunday even with the double trials should end by about 2pm or so. On the weekend our judges will again be Ted McCall along with Dr. Robert and Cathryn Knight who will switch between Novice/Open & Utility. As always, the crating will be at a premium and so we ask for your help in removing your crate(s) if you are not showing. Crating for all 3 days is in ring #4 & #5 as well as the center aisle. If you are one who needs to remove a crate, you can take it home by Thursday December 8 or simply find a spot to store it neatly near the rear right door area.


Staffing these trials has changed slightly since covid appeared almost 3 years ago. Prior to covid 4 Stewards were the ring staff standard. There is a table steward who manages the paperwork for the judge. Then both Novice and Open require a figure 8 heeling pattern but no longer use stewards as figure 8 posts. So, the steward count has been reduced to 3 with two cones replacing the need for 2 people posts. So as a bare minimum 3 stewards but if we can get 4 this is a bonus plus.

Along with great judges, great facility and hospitality from our members, the job of the stewards very often ring hight praise from our guest and from the judges. On the job training for those wanting to learn is also possible. I also suggest for new stewards to sign up for the match a week earlier or contact Ralph if you can come to a training class to be a practice steward. After all of that said you Judge will brief you before each trial begins.

Starting with the October club meeting there will be a sign up for stewards to volunteer for one or more days at these trials. The premium list for exhibitors has been proofed and just went out for entries.

CHANGE TO STANDING RULES

Be sure your dues are paid by end of December or you will have to pay new price

9. MEMBERSHIP INITIATION FEE: \$50 Plus Membership Dues as listed below:

Junior Membership \$20 Single Membership \$35 \$35

Household Membership \$45" \$50 Life Membership (25 years +) -0-

A. A \$10.00 late fee will be added if not paid before the first day of January of each year.

B. If membership has lapsed more than 6 (six) months the late fee is \$25.00

C. The uppermost limits for dues shall not exceed \$150.00

D. Dues are payable on or before the first day of January of each year. Dues paid on new memberships accepted after September 1, will be considered current and paid for the following year. No member may vote whose dues are not paid for the current year. During the month of November, the Treasurer shall send to each member a statement of dues for the ensuing year by Chatter-Barks newsletter, e-mail, or electronic mail.

E. If membership has lapsed more than 1 dar, 6 months it is a new membership.

F. The BOD may grant an additional 90 days to delinquent members in meritorious cases. They may not vote until dues are paid.

G. Members are required to help clean the building or work an event_1 (one) time each 6 (six)

months to qualify for class discounts and 1/2 price Awards Banquet.


