

OBEDIENCE CLUB OF DAYTONA

GENERAL MEETING

JANUARY 9, 2023

President Michele Lemole called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and thanked everyone for coming. The sign in sheet had been passed around sixteen members were present. There were no guests at the meeting.

Report of the Secretary: There were two new applications for membership: Peggy Duhl (S) Ormond Beach, Patricia and Harvey Shulman (HS) De Leon Springs (ok for January ML/LH). There was no correspondence.

Wins and Brags were announced at this meeting. Any new ones should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks. Ralph received a card from Novice Judge Nancy Hayes thanking our membership for inviting her to judge our trial. She said we had a great show, great exhibitors, plenty of great stewards, and great food. She is going to be a snowbird now and will be a local Judge for several months every year.

Repairs: Pat Mozden said J&J Gutter has been busy from the hurricanes. They will probably fix our gutter in about two weeks. The estimate is for \$300. Jim will fix the light bulbs in the back corner of the training center.

Michele said we will be doing our fastcat contract for next year so at one point we will be looking for volunteers for that. Our Agility Trial is January 20, 21, and 22. We have our Agility Trial every year. It is a hugh fundraiser for our club at Silver Sands Bridle Club on 415 in New Smyrna. We have had this trial for about 15 years and we are asking for volunteers starting on Thursday the 19th, then Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The French Club from Mainland High School will be coming over the weekend. They will assist us with course setting and bar setting. There are other things to do. We need people to run score sheets up to the trial Secretary. There is also a timer and a scribe we normally have an agility person do the scribing because it can be a little complex. There is also gate stewarding which is a similar idea. We need help between each class setting the next course. We have 2 rings. The Jumpers ring has jumps, rings and tunnels. We also have the Standard ring which would have the A-Frame, Dog Walk and the Teeter along with the other things Tunnels, Jumps, and Weave Poles. That is the ring with the heaviest items. We'll take help from anybody whether you can lift heavy stuff or not. It's really fun. It takes a lot of work and we have a really good time. It is a really good fundraiser and one of those things that helps us stay in this building. Renee mentioned at our Board meeting that we are spending more money and the classes are a little lower so it would be great if you could come out and help at our Agility Trial and make it really successful. You can let me know if you can come out even for a few hours that would be fantastic. We will take any help we can get. Linda Hudak said there is plenty to do, the course is covered with a roof and the weather has been good. You can come out for a morning or an afternoon slot. Michaele Calderone will be on site. She is our volunteer co-ordinator. She will help find a job for you.

Agility Classes: Agility Foundations classes 1 & 2 are held at the Training Center and are taught by Linda Hudak and Michele Lemole. Linda and Michele will have agility classes Novice Prep., Open, and Excellent Masters at the Silver Sands location. Claire Isrealson and Jean VanHorn teach Fun Agility Classes at the Training Center on Thursdays.

Fly Ball in the training center is being considered but we are waiting for more information.

Fastcat will be offered at Silver Sands during the trial.

Companion Dog Sport Program CDSP may be holding an obedience trial in May. It's great practice for people who are going to show in AKC. It's helpful for people who have dogs that are a little sensitive. You're able to talk to the dog and also treat the dog after the exercise. You have to register the dog with a lifetime registration for \$20.

Dana has suggested a Seminar with Michele Pouliot. She is an Obedience trainer as well as a Freestyle competitor. She teaches through Karen Pryer Academy who does clicker training and behavior training. Dana will get back to us with more information.

Ralph is doing tracking in the first week of February. He is able to do 4 TD's this year but no TDU's because they lost their location and was unable to get another. The Orlando farm was sold and our new site for the TD is at Rock Springs Park West of Lake Mary on SR-46. With this change we are not planning the TDU for this year.

Linda Hudak said we are looking for our scentwork trial this year in April 21,22, and 23. The Jacksonville trial is May 6 and 7.

Michele asked if we had a motion to adjourn.
