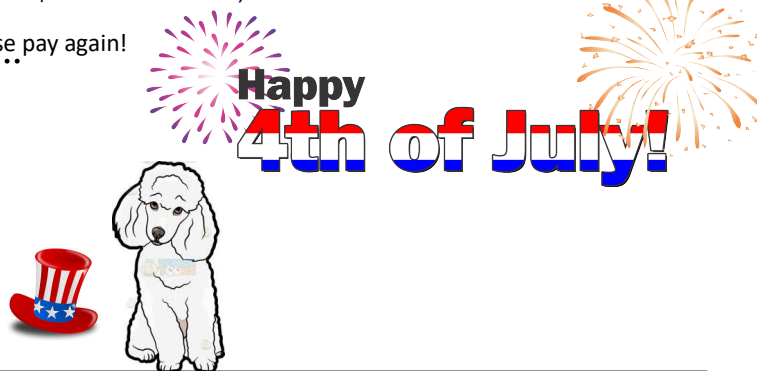

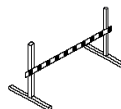

HEAT STROKE IN DOGS

A hot environment or overexertion, such as running or playing too hard, can cause heat stroke in this hot summer weather.

Keep a close eye on your dog . Plan your exercise times in the cooler parts of the day.

Dogs cool by two means: conduction and evaporation.

Conduction happens when a dog lies on a cool surface such as a tile floor and the heat transfers to the floor.

Evaporation happens with heavy panting.

Since dogs only sweat a little and it is only through their footpads, it is not considered a significant means of cooling their body.

Progression of heat stroke:

STAGE	BODY TEMP.	SYMPTOM
Normal	101 F to 102.5 F	None
Heat Stress	103 F or more	Panting, drinking water (if available), restless
Heat Exhaustion	105 F or more	Faster panting, heart rate higher, gums red and tacky, weakness. Collapse may occur.
Heat Stroke	107 F to 109 F	Shock, vomiting, diarrhea, seizures, collapse. multiple organ shutdown. Death possible.

June 10, 2019

Meeting was called to order by Pat Mozden at 7:04PM.

Sign in sheet was passed around and is attached to hard copy of minutes. 23 members were present and Nancy Harrington was our guest.

Wins and brags: were announced and any new ones will be posted in Chatterbarks if you send them to Joan.

Our program was presented by Ralph Orlando and Linda Hudak after the meeting.

Minutes of the last meeting were emailed and so were not read at the meeting.

Report of the secretary: Four single membership applications were read: Brooke Fuchs from Port Orange, Debra Kuhnly from Ormond Beach, Nancy Govoni from Port Orange and Kathy Lo from New Smyrna Beach. A few days after the meeting, another application was found in my folder for Nancy Harrington from Astor. A thank you letter from our SW judge Lisa Mallory was read thanking us for our hospitality and most excellent stewards.

Report of the Treasurer:

April Income: \$9,546 (Eye Clinic = ~\$2.4K and Advanced Classes ~\$2K)

April Expenses: \$13,703.74 (Rent ~\$6.2K and Insurance ~\$2.1K)

May Income: \$18,901.22 (Scent Work Trial ~\$8.7K and Seminar ~\$3K)

May Expenses: \$10,356.00 (Rent ~\$2.9K and Professional Fees ~\$1.5K)

Report of the Board of Directors:

Sale of our Building: Our building is still for sale and the owner has advised us that someone is interested in buying it. The asking price is \$450,000. Our lease would still be valid if a sale does occur.

DOCOF Seminar: Victory Hulett will present a seminar at the end of August to benefit DOCOF. Audit spots are still available for \$60.

Conditioning Seminar: will be held June 23rd from 10 to 3. BYOLunch. Audit spots still available.

Training Director Position: Reneé will be stepping down as a training director, so we are looking for someone to replace her and work with Ralph.

Scheduling Director: We are looking for someone to take over the scheduling of classes and events held in our building. Reneé will help in the transition. This person should be detail oriented in order to keep classes and events organized on a yearly basis.

Maintenance Director: We are still looking for someone who most likely lives nearby and can keep track of work needing to be done at the building. This person does not need to

do the work, but be available to let third party workers into the building and oversee whatever needs to be done.

Sunshine Committee: Kelly Zen will be our new Sunshine person. Her contact info will be on the home page of the newsletter so that any member can let her know if another member is in need of our thoughts and prayers.

Claire could use some help putting the mats down in the agility room so that exhibitors can place their crates back there and members can also temporarily store theirs back there too. Stewards and workers for the trial are asked to be there by 7:30AM both days to assist the judges in setting up rings and paperwork before the trial starts.

New Business:

Public Education: Sandy reported that she spoke at the Lions Club in Ormond By The Sea and had a table at the Ormond Brewing Fundraiser. While there, a member of the DBPD mentioned that their teams could use Kongs for the dogs.

August Scent Work Trials: Pat Dean is requesting stewards for the August 17 and 18 Scent Work trials.

The Obedience Club of Daytona is pleased to announce that **Julie Hill** will be coming to our training center for a **Competition Obedience Workshop** on November 23rd & 24th, 2019.

Julie's workshops emphasize motivation in the training process. She teaches all obedience exercises in the context of creating and maintaining a relationship between dog and handler that demonstrates "the utmost in willingness and enjoyment" as well as performance consistency.

Julie's training techniques incorporate play, games, tricks, and rewards into the training process. In this workshop, Julie will show participants how use these motivational techniques to build a strong and reliable foundation, teach and proof the exercises and prepare to compete.

Specific topics include: shaping behaviors, heeling, the details (fronts, finishes and pivots), reinforcing positions and behaviors, proofing, corrections, dealing with stress, and a detailed discussion about how to teach all obedience exercises. Participants will have ample floor time to try Julie's techniques, and work with her on their problem exercises.
