

All dogs are eligible to earn <u>AKC Therapy Dog titles,</u>

including purebreds and mixed breeds. To earn an AKC Therapy Dog title, dogs must be registered or listed with AKC and have a number. This includes any one of these three options:


- 1. AKC Registration Number (purebreds with registered parents)
- 2. This is often known as the "AKC papers" provided to a dog owner by a breeder. If you have received a registration paper from your breeder or previous owner you can register online.
- 3. PAL Number (purebreds not registerable)
- 4. PAL is Purebred Alternative Listing. PAL (formerly called ILP) is a program that allows unregistered dogs of registerable breeds to compete in AKC Performance and Companion Events. PAL dogs include the many wonderful purebred dogs who may have come from shelters or rescue without AKC registration.
- 5. Canine Partners Number (for mixed breeds or non registerable)
- 6. Used by mixed breed dogs (and dogs otherwise not registered with AKC such as some purebreds from other countries). A special Canine Partners Therapy Dog Enrollment Form is available for mixed breed Therapy Dogs needing to obtain a dog number in order to receive their Therapy Dog Title. This form must be submitted together with the Therapy Dog Title Application.

Ksusha earned 380 out of a possible 400 points and finished 36th of 112 dogs. No ribbon, but the real reward was just being there and competing with some of the best rally dogs in the country.

<u>Bill Creager and "Shadow"</u> his Belgian Tervuren Shadow, qualified for three Titles at the Sonlight Agility Club Scent Trials in Brooksville, Florida. On 7/12 7& 13/2021, "Shadow" qualified for his 3rd legs in Master's Exterior (SEM) and Master Buried (SBM). Shadow, who has now completed all his Master level requirements also qualified as an AKC Master Scent Dog, (SWM). "Shadow also earned a 1st Place Win in Open A on 7/19/21 at the OCOD Trials.

Linda Stites and Winetime Shooting Star "Star" her toy poodle,, earned her CDX Title with a 4th Place Win at the OCOD Obedience Trial on7/17/21.

July 12, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 by President Linda Hudak

Sign in sheet was passed around – 26 members were present and there were 2 guests who signed up to join OCOD. Wins and Brags were announced. Any new ones should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks. Minutes of the last meeting were not read but were published in the Chatterbarks.

Report of the Secretary: There were 5 new applications for memberships. Mary Ann White (S) DB, Crystal Shreve (S) Ponce Inlet, Sue and Rob Hughes (HH) Deland, Janet Mizoguchi (S) Palm Coast, Jodi Eiland (S) Daytona, Jim Danhauer (S) South Daytona. There was no correspondence.

Report of the Treasurer: Renee discussed how much we took in and how much we spent for the month. She mentioned how well we did with the match, the eye clinic and the building fund. We need about 5K per month to run the training center. The water bill for the club has been higher because of the toilet running which has been fixed so if you notice anything wrong please let us know.

Linda Hudak announced that we would be having the drawing on the raffle basket shortly and if anyone needed some tickets they should hurry and get them.

Pat Mozden has been cleaning and arranging items in the training center's storage area upstairs. You will have to stay outside the marked border that protects the electrical equipment and major power supply. This area has to be free of all clutter.

Linda Hudak wanted to thank Linda Stites who planned and organized our match and all of the 24 volunteer workers that had come to help. Thanks to all of the judges and those who contributed their time. We received lots of complements on the building and the way the match ran. Thanks to Claire and those who cleaned before and after the match. The match was a great opportunity for new members to learn how to steward. Thanks to you all for all of your hard work. Your effort is greatly appreciated.

There was a discussion about contacting Barbara regarding correcting an item on line regarding the newsletter.

Renee reminded us that we are having a Scent Trial on September 17, 18, 19.and we will need lots of volunteer workers. These are really simple jobs and she will need 5 volunteers for each ring. You will be able to see how the dogs work to find the scent. After you see the dogs in action you might want to take the classes we offer in Scent Work. :-)

Lisa Liguori wants to remind us that she will be starting a Foundations Agility Class on July 29. For information call Lisa.

Claire and several of her friends have tried the restaurant in our parking lot. It has a new owner and they really liked the food. You can call ahead and they will have it ready for you. It is also convenient if you are here for the trial.

Ralph was talking about competitions. Rally and Obedience have 2 per year, one in July and one in December. Our Agility trial is in January at Silver Sands when the weather is cooler. February is the Tracking Test. Ralph said we are limiting entries in our July Trial because of

covid and social distancing. We don't want people congregating around rings and we don't want people visiting that are not showing. If you have crates in the center aisle you will need to remove them if you are not in the trial. Pat M. asked if we still need covid waivers. Linda Hudak said we will continue collecting waivers. We're expecting our numbers of people entering to be in the high 50's. Those people may have more than one dog entered. Exhibitors can bring their crates in and start setting them up as early as 3-5 PM on Thursday.

Ralph had a message from Volusia County Sheriff's Department asking if he could help collect donations for a K9 Memorial for Police dogs killed in the line of duty. He also had asked if they needed any type of equipment. They requested an infrared light to put on their lapel so helicopters could see where the good guys were in the darkness. They were so grateful they invited us to a demo of their dogs training at their training area...it was awesome! Ralph is hoping for that again. For the Military dogs Ralph has raised a nest egg of money from people giving equipment for him to sell or charitable donations. He was saying his golf group donates their winnings every week. He went into the VA in Port Orange and brought a jug for donations. Ralph went up to the bar and they started putting money in the jug. Then he went to the motorcycle club last Saturday. They passed the jug through the rows of 60 members and collected \$350. The grand total is now \$3509. Ralph and Smokey will also be riding by motorcycle with a police escorted group to raise money for the charity Camp Boggy Creek. This is a summer camp for kids with life threatening disabilities. 




