Pat is also reminding us that our section of the parking lot is supposed to be paved approximately the third week in July. Pat Mozden will send us a message through Pat Dean when the work is beginning.

Ralph said first of all a big shout out to this lady over here Linda Campagna for gathering up stewards for the trial. I came in yesterday morning to do the lines for the crates at the trials and Anna jumped in and helped and it went superfast. We also had Cheryl Robinson helping. I couldn't believe it went so fast. I did see the grass people cutting the grass over by the apartments this morning so I tried to ask the supervisor to see if they could do our area here. He had already left but I will be in contact with him by phone. There are a few more stewards needed for the trial. I have marked in yellow on the chart where they are needed. Hopefully we will get filled up but if we don't Linda Campagna will get on it. Make sure you wear your club shirt and you'll be getting your steward badge. The doors will open at 7am on Friday so the exhibitors can come in. Food is coming from Jimmy Johns each day. After the trial I will need 6 people to tidy up on Sunday and do light cleaning.

Linda Hudak asked if anyone had information about pet insurance and Ralph came up and said he had insurance on 4 of his 5 dogs. Prices on the policies are based on age. He has Pet Partners and Healthy Paws. Some insurance policies allow holistic others do not. For a young dog it would cost \$30 a month an older dog would be \$50 a month. Both policies have a \$500 deductible. One policy has a limit on the amount paid the other policy does not have a limit. One of his policies pays 70%. His other policy pays 80%. AKC's policy is called Fetch. Claire likes her Nationwide policy which has a \$250 deductible. They have a list of conditions that are covered and those that are not. Claire signed up online. Linda said her dog has an ongoing issue that has been hard to diagnose. Linda Hudak would like to have an insurance representative come in to talk to the club. She asked if there were any other questions or topics we hadn't covered. Linda motioned

to adjourn and Pat seconded it. Meeting was adjourned at 7:33pm
