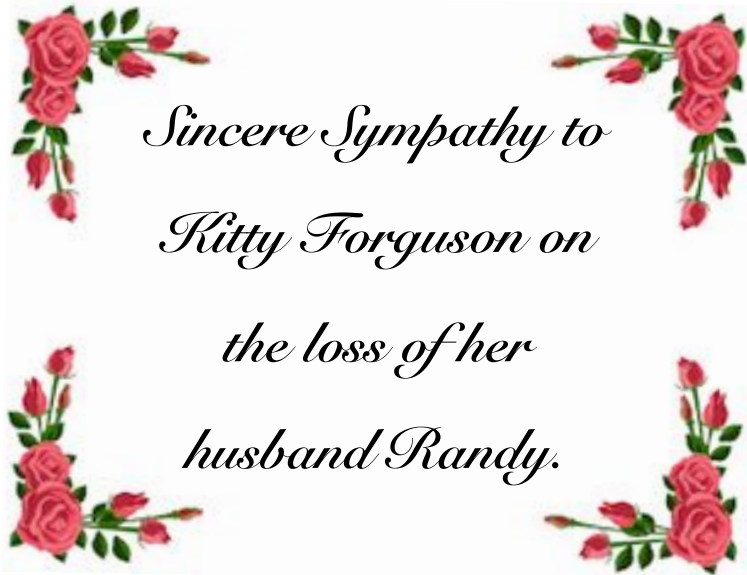

### General Meeting Minutes

August 13, 2018

Meeting was called to order by Pat Mozden at 7:35PM after the presentation of medical style muzzles to the sheriff's department. They had requested them as something that each handler can carry with them in the event the handler becomes disabled and another handler has to take control of the dog while the dog's handler is treated and/or transported for injuries. At everyone's request, the dogs were brought in and a question and answer session followed. Pat thanked Ralph and Sandy for their work on supporting the MWDs and Sheriff's K9s.

Sign in sheet was passed around and is attached to hard copy of minutes. 34 members were present and no guests.

Wins and brags were announced and will be posted in Chatterbarks if you send them to Joan. Minutes of the last meeting were published in the newsletter and so were not read at the meeting. No additions or corrections were made.

Report of the Treasurer:

July Expenses: \$12,665.51 (Trials were ~\$7.9K and Rent ~\$2.8K)

July Income: \$16,413.50 (Trials ~\$7.3K and Classes ~\$6.1K)

July Obedience and Rally Trials income was 7,340.00 and expenses were \$7347.76. Plus an additional expense for catalogues of \$295.

Report of the Board of Directors:

Proposed By-Laws Amendment: Pat called for a motion to vote on the change to the By-Laws as was published in the newsletter. 34 were in favor and none opposed.

Excessively high water bill for July: Pat reported that our water bill this month was back to a more normal \$91 and we'll have a plumber check out the toilets.

Club Shirt Chair: We are looking for someone to take over the sale of club shirts.

Companion Dog Sports Program: Kris Davenport would like to encourage interest in our club participating in this program. Information will be published and everyone interested in participating should contact Kris. Claire suggested we have a class geared toward what this entails. The program includes obedience type of trials, but on a much more relaxed level and is geared toward a way to make new exhibitors to the sport more relaxed in their first exposure to companion dog events.

Remembering Hoke: Pat reported that we are looking for a permanent way to honor Hoke who was so instrumental in building up our club almost from day one to what we are today. Donations in his honor may be made to the Pulmonary Fibrosis Foundation or to OCOD.

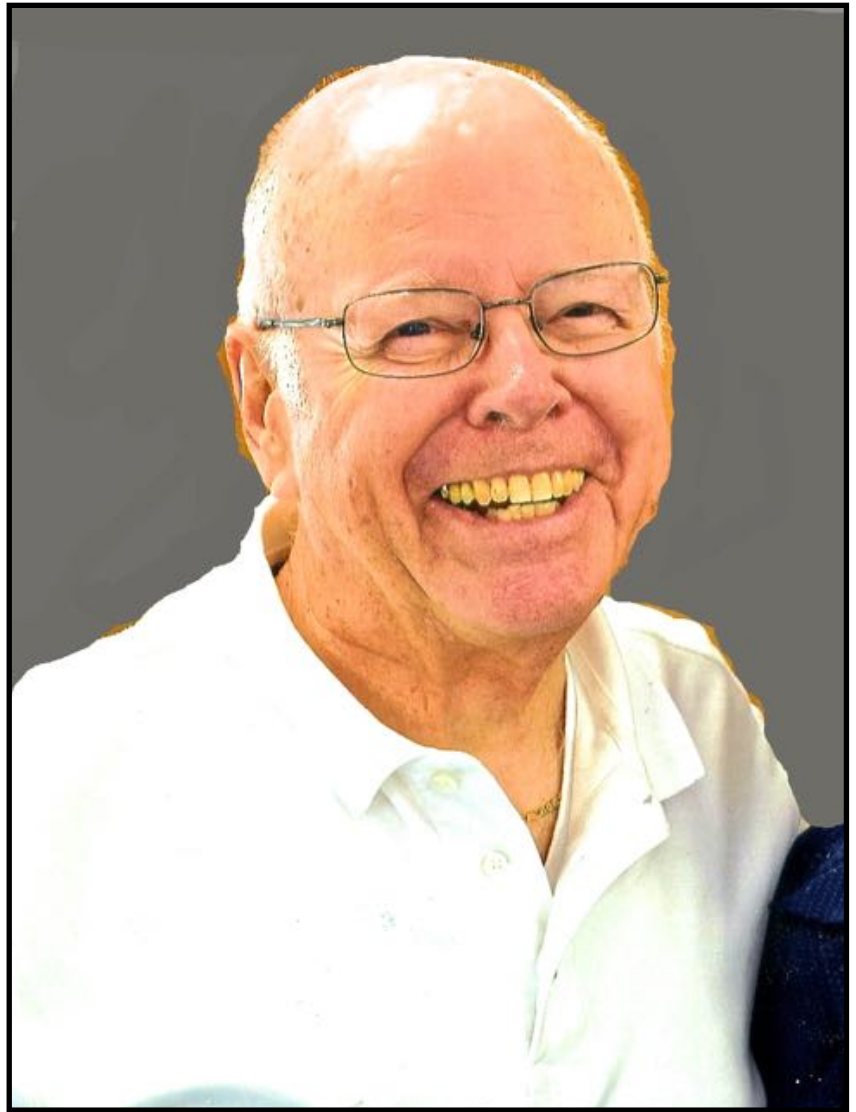

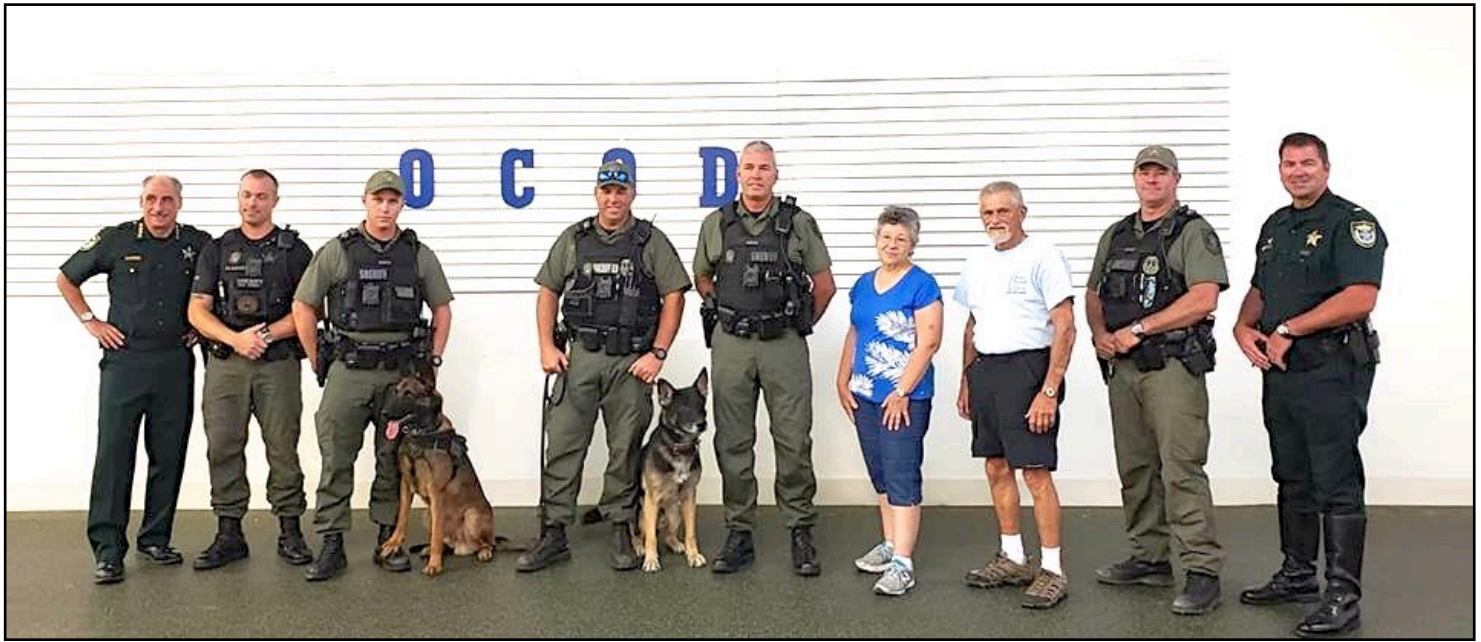

Tags are \$7.45 each and include the title earned and date earned.

Excerpt from the standing rules:

### TITLE AWARDS

- A. Upon receiving a dog's title
  1. A member may purchase a plaque bearing dog's registered name and call name
- B. All titles received by same dog may be purchased and will be printed on hanging tags with title and date earned
- C. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman.
- D. A proof will be sent before ordering to be sure spellings and awards are correct, and must be returned to Chairman with approval.
- E. All plaques and tags must be paid for in advance of order.

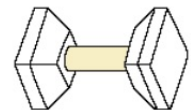

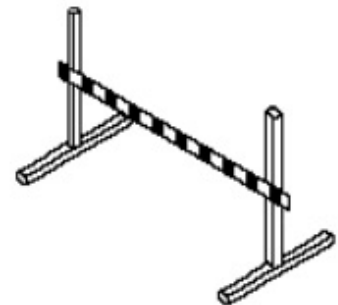
