General Meeting Minutes

Date 8.10.2020

Meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by President Linda Hudak (before guest speaker*)

Sign in sheet was passed around-15 members present; no guests.

Our speaker was Lind Weaver; topic was how dogs process scent and the different levels in scent work.

Wins & Brags were announced- new ones can be submitted to Joan via email and will be posted in upcoming Chatterbarks.

Minutes of the last meeting were not read but were published in Chatterbarks

- Report of the President:
 - Linda H. expressed her appreciation for the patience from the members regarding the changes we are experiencing and how we are working at moving forward in general.
 - The club is currently catching up on classes that were affected at the time of the shutdown. While the club is reaching out to instructors willing to come back to teach, and individuals that want to come back to train, Linda said that she does understand that it is a personal decision in regard to what people are comfortable with for themselves at this time. It's an important point to keep in mind.
- Report of the Secretary: 1 new membership application: (SM) Monica Miles, Ponte Vedra. No other correspondence.
- Report of the Treasurer:

July Income: a loss of <\$884.92> was reported. Per Renee, the accounts are in good standing at the moment. Linda H. added that event cancellations are a big factor in our numbers being down (Brevard Trial is still on our schedule for October) and smaller activities that can bring in some form of income should be explored. We need to be creative to generate income i.e: The virtual rally courses will continue to be set up on Saturdays, there is the eye clinic coming up in September and possibly getting the dental cleaning on the schedule.

An inquiry from a member: 'would it be beneficial to charge for crate space for those that need to leave their crate at training center, especially ones that are large and can't be broken down easily?' May be an option; possible discussion for board in future.

Linda addressed a question from a member on how does the class safety protocol routine work. She reminded the meeting attendees that between the instructor and the person working the desk, we have the tray at the door to step in for our shoes, temperatures are being taken as people enter, the Covid waiver for attending class is signed, the safety protocol form is initialed- Once class has begun, there should be no touching others' equipment and others' dogs- you train your own dog. Class sizes are smaller (downsized and manageable)-Instructors should bring their own dogs a demo dog. Instructors will need to work through different scenarios and be prepared to tweak- what works, what doesn't and what needs to be addressed. Assess as it occurs keeping safety in mind.

Reminder that there will need to be a vote to change/amend bi-law based on AKC's requirement to allow our club to have Virtual meetings if we decide that in the future we have a need to use this method.

OCOD 'S Virtual DOCOF Team



TITLE AWARDS

- C. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman.
- D. A proof will be sent before ordering to be sure spellings and awards are correct, and must be returned to Chairman with approval.
- E. All plaques and tags must be paid for in advance of order.
