If you would like to receive a plaque and/or hang tag indicating your dog's name and/or titles earned this year, please email your info with correct spelling to **OCODawards@yahoo.com**. **The deadline to get your info and check to her is November 1, 2021.** The price of the Plaques are \$29.00 and Tags are \$8.50  
Excerpt from the standing rules:

### **TITLE AWARDS**

- A. Upon receiving a dog's title
  - 1. A member may purchase a plaque bearing dog's registered name and call name
- B. All titles received by same dog may be purchased and will be printed on hanging tags with title and date earned
- C. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman.
- D. A proof will be sent before ordering to be sure spellings and awards are correct, and must be returned to Chairman with approval.
- E. All plaques and tags must be paid for in advance of order.

## **Agility Foundation 1 Class at the Training Center**

This Foundation Class is the first step for Teams to learn agility handling skills. Prospective Teams must have completed a Basic Obedience class or higher, have a good recall, have a good stay and the ability to work off lead to enroll in the class

## General Meeting Minutes

August 9, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by President Linda Hudak

Report of the Treasurer: Renee discussed how much we took in and how much we spent for the month. She paid the mortgage and the condo fee. Report of the Board of Directors: Linda wanted to go over our dates. Sniff & Go will be on Sept. 11th the information is on Facebook. The Scent trial is on Sept. 17, 18, & 19. Renee said the trial closes on the 16th. Renee said you can never sign up on the web you have to send it in snail mail. They need lots of helpers for boxes and tables. They will tell you what to do. Please bring in old pocketbooks to be used in the scent trial. They need people to set up on Thursday before the trial ... There will be no classes after 3pm except for Joan and her graduating class.

If you have any awards coming for this year contact Vicki Owens and send her your money. We haven't had any decisions on the restaurants for the Christmas Banquet yet. A lot of restaurants are short staffed this year and we may end up having it at the TC and just have it catered. There was a lengthy discussion about the restaurants and after a majority vote they decided to have it at the training center and cater the food.

Linda was letting everyone know that soon we will be able to send payments and applications online for our puppy classes. We are also updating descriptions for all the classes that we offer. The Building Committee with Pat and Jim is working on cleanup and a few small repairs. We're also working on another outdoor basic class in Port Orange for October. Is anyone missing a chair? We have some extra chairs in storage waiting to be claimed. Linda B. needs someone to take over the membership roster. Please contact her if you can help out.

We will be having the Mid Florida Golden Retriever Club trial this week. They will be setting up Thursday afternoon.

Lynn Weaver will be speaking about AKC Farm Dogs Certification. It's a very simple process. Lynn said AKC has Farm Dogs governed under herding. Farm Dogs is treated by AKC as an outside Sport like Barn Hunt or Dock Diving. To get certified you would have to get 2 Q's under 2 judges. Luckily we have 2 judges in the club Janet and Lynn. There are 12 elements. Some of the things required in the Trial are as follows: walk around wheel barrow, walk through building and jump on hay, feed on ground, walk on wire grate and mud, owner feeds livestock while leaving dog behind, walk around course including farm animals, meet and greet, physical exam, and noise distraction like turning a tractor on and off. The dog doesn't have to be perfect. Judges can have trials and the application is only \$35. Please contact Lynn Weaver for more information. Thanks to Lynn for a most interesting and informative explanation of this certification. ☺

Ralph wanted to give us an update on the Sheriff's dog memorial fund. It is almost 4K now. Ralph has now raised \$750 on his go fund me page and will be in the Boggy Creek run in the first week in October.
