The minutes from the last meeting were in the newsletter.

The Guest Speaker is Julie Shinew, a veterinarian assistant that has been cleaning teeth for over 30 years. She did a demonstration of her practice so that everyone could understand her practice of therapeutic dentistry.

Report of the Secretary: New Membership applications were received from Linda Hubbard, Shannon Shepard, Diane Gordon, Eric Jakob, Joyce Silvernail, and Candace Hopkins. Thank you notes were received from the following clubs Vested Interest in K9's Inc., Southeast Volusia Humane Society, Carolina Poodle Rescue, and Arni.

Report of the Treasurer:

Hoke Johnson wanted to remind the membership that there is always a setback for the month of February since the expenses from the Agility Trial are totaled in. Hoke would like to remind everyone that they should put their name, date and the amount of money in the envelope on the outside of it.

Committee Report:

Pat Mozden wanted to remind everyone that the AKC has dedicated the month of September as responsibility dog owner month; the club does a responsible dog owner day at the Volusia Mall for September 12th 2015.

The dancing dog show will be May 6th this year; it will be the biggest show that the club has ever had 28 members dancing in the show.

Hope Johnson would like to donate tables to the club for the upcoming trials.

Tracking test is taking place on March 22nd.

The new Agility A-Frame will be delivered on Wednesday the 11th. The Towels being sold tonight are being collected for Ralph and Nina to throw a spring party for the returning soldiers and their children.

New Business:

A letter written to the club by Alan Wilcox, regarding the videotaping in the seminars was discussed. The final decision by the membership was that when contracting each trainer for a seminar it will be asked if they do or don't want videotaping. Helen Carter was approved by the board to use the puppy tunnels for a miniature schnauzer event, she will return it. It was approved as long as it is returned clean.

The membership was asked if they thought the newsletter should continue to be mailed to local vets offices, as the postage goes up it is becoming a monthly expense. It was discussed and decided that it be discontinued. In the puppy room there were toys that are battery operated Nina had bought, they are now missing.

The board and membership agreed to reimburse her \$30. She will be getting a lock to store them in her crate and lock it.

A request by Renee Johnson was brought to the board; it was a proposal for the Economy Electric Company to replace any fluorescent lights in the back storage room and a few of the outlets around the building. The estimate is for it not to exceed \$600, Mrs. Johnson will be checking with the building landlord to see if he will pick up some cost.

Julia Shinew passed around a sheet to sign up if you would like her to come to the building on a Saturday to clean the dog's teeth.

The OCOD Tracking Test on March 22, 2015 followed the Central Florida Tracking test held on March 15. Two of the teams who had entered that test and also entered our test as a backup passed on March 15th. So of the 5 teams scheduled for the OCOD test 2 now called to withdraw their entry.

Then just a week or so before our Test date one judge hurt her leg and had to cancel her judging assignment.

Luckily Robin Scott our scheduled Chief Track Layer and brand new provisional judge was able to step in and be the 2nd judge for the test.

Of the 3 remaining teams 1 did pass (a mini-long haired Doxie).

If you have not tracked with your dog you are missing one of the most rewarding events that you and your partner can compete in and I am not sure the excitement in finding the glove has an equal in the high you get. Sniffing is a natural dog behavior so training the handler to believe in the dog is maybe the most difficult part to learn.

Next year the plan is to offer the TD test and the TDU.
