### About Club Dollars

Hi All.

As one of two training directors we often share the job but in different areas. I am also on other committees to help our club run as smoothly as possible.

I handle disbursement of the seminar and class credits. Instructors are issued both and assistants just the class credits. At the end of each month, if a class has ended, I expect The ACCURATE report to me and should include the full names, day taught, who instructed and who assisted and hours for the period. The report for classes of more than one month are sent to me in the finish month (usually puppy, basic and intermediate).

Instructor class hours are converted to credit slips at the rate of 1 hour equals \$10.00 for instructors and half of that for each assistant for all of the normal classes. For classes considered advanced classes the rate is 1 hour equals \$15.00 mainly to keep in line with the higher fee the student pays for these classes. For the classes that are scheduled for 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours and also at \$15/hour, fractions of a dollar take place so now for these amounts I am rounding up/down to the nearest dollar amount.


Your class credits can be used to take classes in obedience, agility and ring time. For many of you that I know take classes or use ring time I will break down the pay credit in values to help you use one slip for a class or as ring time. Instructors will get from \$40 to over \$100 in class credit so letting me know what denominations work best for you will help me out a lot.

One last important thing to mention is the published staff for a class matching the actual staff who was there. There are often big changes from published to actual and when your class final report is sent to me if they don't match I have to do some extra detective work to get to the bottom of who gets what. So, as each class begins go to the bulletin board or website and make sure the staff matches that posted. If they do not match please contact Renee' Johnson to let her know of the discrepancy, she will then make the correction and post the change.

I for one can proudly say that our Training Center run by all of you is one of the best.
