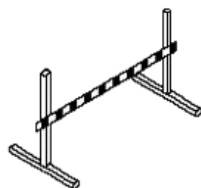

The purpose of the Canine Good Citizen Test is to ensure that our favorite companion, the dog, can be a respected member of the community because it is trained and conditioned to act mannerly in the home, in public places and in the presence of other dogs. The program embraces both purebred and mixed-breed dogs, as the anti-canine sentiment does not discriminate between the purebred and the nonpurebred.

Canine Good Citizen training is fun and useful. Through it, you and your dog will establish a closer bond, and your dog will have the added benefit of knowing how to please you. This test of your dog's manners and training is not a competition and does not require that you and your dog perform with precision.

The American Kennel Club urges all dog owners to participate in this program, thereby assuring that our beloved dogs will always be welcome and respected members of the community.

If you're suffering from a lack of praise and appreciation, you'll want to seriously consider signing up to steward at this summer's OCOD Obedience Trials, Saturday and Sunday, July 18-19.

Every year we hear the same kind of praise from those who judge our trials and those who enter:

A number of club members turn up each year to work as stewards.

If you're thinking of preparing your dog for obedience performance, there's no better way to learn the ways of the ring than to steward.

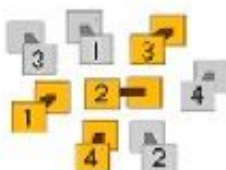
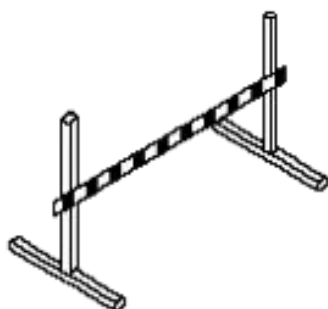
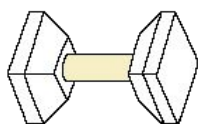
And no experience is needed. We train!

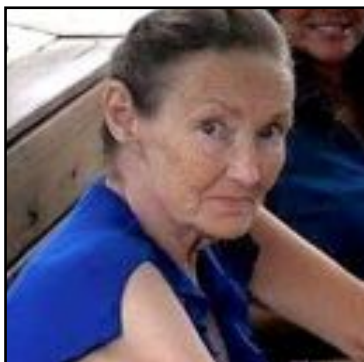
