



The Obedience Club of Daytona would like to welcome and congratulate our newest judge. Cheri Tyre-Roberts is now an AKC agility judge.





Report of the Treasurer:

April Income: \$9,349.66 April Expense: \$7,964.33 Total for April: \$1,385.33

Report of Committees:

- **Public Education:** Bishop's Glenn is having an event on Wednesday June 8th from 1 to 3pm. Joan will send out information on the event.
- New Class Committee: Rally Free will be offered in the near future
- Window Committee: A suggestion was made to have posters made of people's dogs. They may purchase these to have them put in the windows. They are not very expensive. An email will be sent out for any club member who is interested.
- Bylaws and Standing rules committee: In the constitution, we need to vote to remove life members getting free classes. We also need to vote on using seminar credits for dog seminars related to club policies only in the standing rules.

A vote was taken to amend the Constitution (By-Laws Article 1 Membership) to remove: life members receive free classes: Motion by Ellen Farmer 2nd by Carole Schultz to make this change to the Constitution. There was discussion about this. Vote: 51 approve, 0 no. Standing rules #4G amended to state that Seminar credits must be used for dog seminars related to club policies only: Vote: 51 approve, 0 no Motion by Carole Schultz, 2nd by Laurel Hendricks. These will both be amended.

Want to Feel Good All Over? Be a Steward!

If you're suffering from a lack of praise and appreciation, you'll want to seriously consider signing up to steward at this summer's OCOD Obedience Trials, Saturday and Sunday, July-16 & 17.

Every year we hear the same kind of praise from those who judge our trials and those who enter: *"Excellent stewards all weekend." "Really GREAT stewards." "We're spoiled. These are the best stewards we've ever had."*

A number of club members turn up each year to work as stewards. They know—as you will, if you've never done it before—that being a steward gets you a ring-side seat, up close and personal, for all the action. Plus lunch and goodies ! If you're thinking of preparing your dog for obedience performance, there's no better way to learn the ways of the ring than to steward. And no experience is needed. We train!

This year, we'll have three obedience rings each day. Three judges. Novice, Open, Utility, and a few non-standard classes. We'll need table stewards to help the judges keep the paperwork in order, and ring stewards to do things like

put out scent articles and gloves, take leashes, deliver dumbbells, set jump heights, and act as posts for the figure-8 exercises. And the main task: to keep the rings running smoothly and our judges happy.
