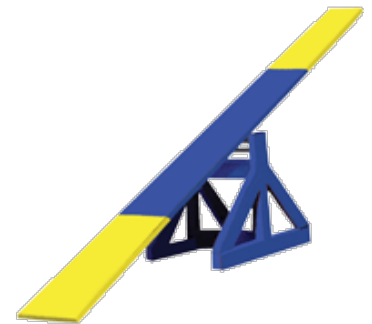
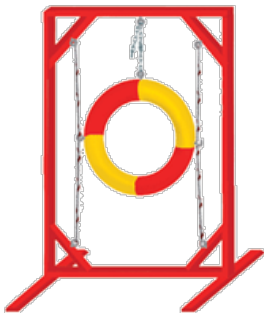

Changes to Standing Rules to be Voted on March 2016

OBEDIENCE CLUB OF DAYTONA, INC. STANDING RULES ~~JANUARY 2016~~ to be voted march 2016

2. **THE PRICE** of the current training classes shall be determined by the Training Directors and Committee to change as needed. *Prices will be posted next to classes when assigned*

- ~~j. Life Members receive free classes for Puppy, Basic, Intermediate, and Agility for their personal dogs~~
i. Must be considered a member ~~60~~ (90) days before eligible for class discounts, this may be waived if new member is an experienced instructor & presently instructing a set of classes.

12. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ANNUAL AWARDS 1/2 PRICE BANQUET

1. Lifetime members receive a free dinner
2. Only two members of a household entitled to this privilege
3. Must work a minimum of ~~5 hours (in same calendar year)~~ one event such as: committee, class, fun day, trial etc. at an activity that directly contributes to the Club's income generating activities. Creditable Work will include but not limited to: instructing or assisting classes, scheduled work at a trial or match, cleaning the training center, helping with agility training and trials, tracking training and trials. Other activities that generate income may be qualified for this list.

13. TITLE AWARDS:

1. Upon receiving a dog's ~~first~~ title:
 - a. A member may purchase a plaque bearing Dog's registered name and call name. *(unless member requests something else) to be paid for in advance of order.*
- ~~2. Club Will Provide:~~
 - b. ~~a. Hanging tags with title and date earned.~~ All following titles received by same dog may be purchased and will be printed on hanging tags, with title and date earned. Club will provide all tags.
 - b. ~~The member must have earned the title while a member of the club, if the club is to provide tag.~~
 - c. ~~Additional tags may be purchased and be paid for in advance~~
 - (c) d. All plaques and tags must be submitted to the Trophy Chairperson in writing on or before the closing date (no exceptions), to be determined by the Awards Chairman
 - ~~(d) All plaques and tags must be paid for in advance of order, and proof read and approved for spelling.~~
