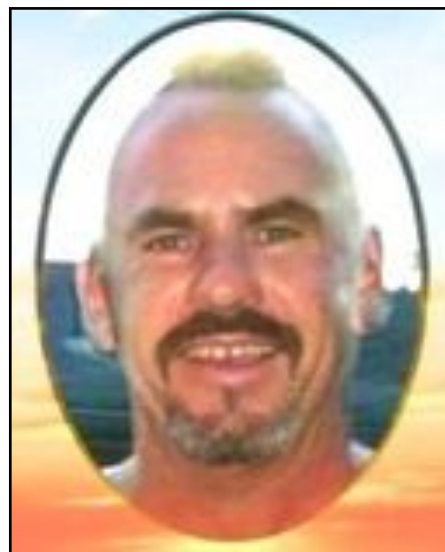

## Additions to Standing Rules to be voted on at the November meeting.

- 4. INSTRUCTORS & ASSISTANTS WHO TEACH** any class are eligible for CLUB DOLLARS, as defined by the Training Committee, and subject to change as necessary. Club Dollars are equal to the number of weeks for the class.
- There will be only one full instructor per class and assistants as needed.
  - Obedience Assistants receive 1/2 the club dollars as the Instructor.
  - Agility instructors and assistants receive full credits as earned per class and distributed by the Agility Director.
  - Once Club Dollars are assigned they are non-transferable except within immediate family memberships
  - Once Club Dollars are assigned they cannot be replaced if lost
  - Club Dollars may be used as determined by the Training Committee
  - Seminar credits may be used for outside seminars related to club policies and OCOD held seminars for audit spots only

**5. ESTABLISHED CLUB MEMBER/TRAINER SEMINAR PRESENTER OR JUDGE.** If such person is qualified and would like to present and offer their expertise for a seminar, such member can be compensated for their services as a Seminar Presenter in accordance to their Professional and Experience Level. In the event that a Club member provides their services as a judge at an AKC Club Trial, such member can be compensated for their services with accordance to other AKC Trial Judges in Florida.

**6. ALL CLUB MEMBERS ATTENDING SEMINARS** shall pay their portion difference in cost, between their past accumulated seminar credit hours and the cost of the seminar, in advance. This refers to the past seminar credits earned prior to March 2014.

- Each Training Director is entitled to one free Board approved seminar per year, up to \$150, during their term that supports Section #2 of the Constitution. They shall be required to present a 20 minute program on the seminar at a time to be scheduled by the program chairperson in a timely manner.

**7. TRAINING DIRECTOR(S)** shall be appointed by the Board of Directors and shall be responsible for the operation of the training classes. Training Directors shall make all decisions regarding the methods and equipment used as well as the content for all classes. Training Directors shall determine the scheduling of the classes, the time classes are held, the cost, and shall be responsible for teaching assignments for the Instructors and Assistants. Training Directors shall have final authority concerning the acceptance for training of every student and dog, and concerning the appointment of Instructors and Assistants.

- Training Directors shall be Chairpersons of the Training Committee composed of three (3) additional club members; 2 of which shall be Instructors, and shall report as required to the Board of Directors and the Club. The training Committee and its members shall be subject to Article V of the Club's By-Laws except that appointments of Instructors and Assistants shall be made by the Training Director(s)
- It is recommended that all Training Directors hold two open general membership training meetings per year, as well as additional training meetings held at their discretion throughout the year, each to be announced in the Chatter-Barks newsletter or e-mail.

**8. THE OBEDIENCE CLUB OF DAYTONA'S TRAINING DIRECTORS RESERVES** the right and option of refusing training to any dog or handler. This is to include classes, ring use, building use and/or any club event such as seminars, tests, trials and matches. Such dog or handler may not attend any function leased to another club in the training building without written consent from Training Directors

- ANY DOG WHICH BECOMES AGGRESSIVE OR DISRUPTIVE TOWARDS OTHER DOGS OR PEOPLE WILL BE DISMISSED "at will"
  - The Training Director, or Instructor, at his/her discretion, reserves the right to dismiss any dog from class without a refund. If your dog is not under control and/or presents a danger to others, you will be dismissed from classes.
