Report from the Pat Mozden Public Education Coordinator

Thank you to Laurel Hendricks, Nina Daly, Rhea Machado, Kelly Zen and Chris Franczek for their support of our efforts to reach out to the public with our messages of responsible pet ownership and training your dog.

October 17th and November 21st. We are holding "Meet the Trainers" at Pet Supermarket in Bellair Plaza from 12 – 2. We distribute information on our classes and answer questions about dog behavior. We may expand this program to other Pet Supermarket locations in 2016.

Saturday October 24th: TBA. Waiting for further information on a potential event.

Sunday, November 1st: Blessing of the Pets at First United of Ormond Beach from 2 – 4 PM. They would like us to do a short demonstration of Basic Obedience behaviors. We could use several members for this event.

Some of these events only require a few people, while others could use a group of members. If you and your dog like to meet new people and you would like to participate in group events, keep these events in mind.

Hush Puppy Haven. This group provides temporary shelter to the pets of domestic abuse victims when they make the decision to leave their dangerous home since the shelters that help them do not allow pets. We collect gently used supplies for dogs and other pets to help the Hush Puppy Haven foster homes. The needs include: bowls, leashes, collars, pet toys, beds/blankets/towels and crates of all sizes. Through the generosity of OCOD members, we have kept them well supplied this year. If you have donations, please mark them with my name (Pat Mozden) and leave them at the front of the training center.

Dog Food Donations: Thanks to Janet Berry, OCOD has been making regular contributions to Sophie's Circle, Volusia's first pet food pantry. A container is located at the front of the Training Center marked for pet food donations to this group. Please keep them in mind.

General Meeting Minutes

September 14, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:06pm by Joan Costello
Guests were welcomed
Wins and Brags were announced
The minutes from the last meeting were in the newsletter.

Report of the Secretary:

10 New members were welcomed. They are: Brandi Delgado, Edward Lutman and Theresa Kern, Renee Jensen, Yolanda Munzert, Kathy Bennett, William and Christine Taliaferro, Pat Dalrymple and Sally Beth MacMaster

Report of the Treasurer:

Income for August: \$8,823.02

Expenses for August: **-\$12,614.97**

Total for August: **-\$3,791.95**

The large expense last month was for a payment to catch up on the electric bill, which had been billed to us incorrectly earlier in the year. Most of the income was from classes and the Kincaid Seminar.

Report of Committees:

Nominating Committee: Pat Mozden gave a list of nominees for the board next year. They are:

Members at Large: Carole Schultz, Linda Hudak, Joe White

All named individuals have accepted their nominations.

Public Education: Pat Mozden talked about the Meet the Trainers event at the Pet Supermarket in Bellair held in August. They had a good turnout and good participation. November 1 we have been asked to participate in a Petfest at a church on beachside. Newman Veterinary Clinic asked us to participate in their grand opening on October 24.

CGC and CGCA will be held on November 2 at the club and the CGCU will be held November 16 at Training Center and at Pet Supermarket in Bellair.

Agility Committee: The agility committee had some proposals that were discussed about equipment purchase, entry fees and ribbons. The committee wanted the membership to discuss the entry fees again but President Joan Costello stated that since it was voted on by the general membership last month to keep the fees as they are we will not address that again. It was proposed to pay the chief course builder and the ring captains a free entry each day or a discounted trial entry each day. There was a lot of discussion on this including paying members to do work at agility trials but not at our other trials. Also, it was mentioned that some of the people doing these jobs may not have a dog entered so they would not get anything. Expiration dates was also suggested if we decide to give out free entries. Robin Scott brought up the idea that there are 2 people who do course building for the fee of usually free entries that are not club members. Pat Mozden made a motion that the agility trial team approach the women (Jackie Harden and Vickie Maloney) to see if they may be interested in being course builders, paying them with free trial entries and or free camping. Additional fees to be negotiated. Renee Johnson 2nd the motion. The majority voted yes. The agility committee stated that they are trying to make the trial better by changing things up. Butch Shalansky also brought up the fact that he has offered to teach course building for the club multiple times but has only done it once. Maria Orlando made a motion for the ring captains to get 1 free entry for our trial next year. The majority voted yes to this. Equipment: Joan Costello read the proposal for new agility equipment. There was discussion on purchasing the new equipment. The equipment can be delivered to Orlando for pickup and this will save the club \$748. Marge Pasalaqua made a motion to purchase the equipment less the shipping. Ralph Orlando 2nd it. Vote: Majority voted yes. Rosettes and awards: Joan gave a list of what the committee wants us to purchase and stated it was not approved by the board. Marge Pasalaqua spoke about the ribbons she bought for the obedience trial and the prices were a lot cheaper. This will be checked into before any purchase is approved.

Building committee: Pat Mozden spoke about purchasing the training center. Pat gave a history of the locations of the club and the places that have been looked at and proposed over the years. The owners are ready to sell the spaces. It is listed as a condominium since 1995. The units are being sold individually. If we don't purchase this unit it will likely be sold. It was discussed that if we tried to get a similar unit in a nicer neighborhood we would not be able to afford it and also it was stated that most places in nice areas would not allow dogs. Pat stated that she thinks the area is stable. Motion was made to speak of the financial information off the record, made by Carole Schultz and 2nd by Laurel Hendricks. It was unanimously approved. Ralph spoke to the membership about the financials. Motion made for the committee to proceed with negotiations by Robin Scott. That motion withdrawn. A motion was made by Renee Johnson to pursue investigation on purchasing the building. 2nd by Shirley Shalansky. This was voted yes.

December 12th and 13th is The Classic in Orlando. Anyone who can help with stewarding please contact Ralph.
